The Organiser requested the Jury to allow the unofficial Swiss Eight-way team to jump outside the competition, provided there is always sufficient capacity to continue the competition.

The jury approved.

## Meeting with FAI Controller and Chief Judges

Elisabet Pettersson FS Chief Judge

Confirmed that everything is ready for the competition to start. The panel is complete.

The Jury President asked how the scores would be handled. The scoring system is functioning correctly. Scores will be posted on a large screen immediately and will be copied onto the scoreboard by Karla Cole. After each round, the judges must initiate the upload to the FAI web site and the Organiser Web site.

A manual Draw will take place at 17h00.

Alya Ananina AE Chief Judge

Confirmed that everything is ready for the competition to start but there is perhaps a problem with the scoring system as it is not quite adapted to AE judging and it has not been tested for AE. The judging panel is complete.

Sylvia Wagner FAI Controller

Confirmed that everything is ready in accordance with the rules. The provisional sanction fee has been paid.

The FAI Controller reported that she had tested the PA system, which was operational, the Jury then requested that this be reviewed and it will be improved.

The Official Information Board is located next to the official scoring notice boards. World Records are already posted and Jury Notices will be posted there too.

A tent is to be set up close to the Tent village, with four screens, two for each discipline, to enable competitors to see their jumps and scores.

The President asked for a description of the emergency services being provided. A Red Cross tent is set up and at all times there are three medical doctors on site with emergency equipment and ability to perform emergency medical procedures, and an ambulance. There are two hospitals in Saarlouis.

All competitors have signed a "Declaration on Drug Usage". In Germany, it is customary to inform organisers two weeks in advance if drug testing is planned. No advance notice has been given but in the event of a control, there is sufficient space to cope with this.


Personal equipment can be stored in a hangar and a security rounds are carried out with personnel accompanied by a dog.

Aircraft is as per the bulletin with all the requirements for the event. If there was a problem the organiser feels that there are sufficient aircraft anyway but other aircraft are available elsewhere.

The President asked what media arrangements have been made? The organiser contacted Flying Aces who confirmed that they would not be present but also confirmed that they owned all rights. A daily report will be made on the radio and contacts have been made with both German and French television.

A hard drive will be provided to the Judges Committee and DVDs will be available. The question remains as to how to order them and when?

The Jury was satisfied that the all was in order for the competition to commence.
